80th Anniversary of VE Day Commemorations - Monday 5th May

After the bowling we shall have an impromptu party at the club to join in the national celebration's. To get us into the mood and evoke the spirit, sounds and scenes of the time and take us back to that momentous day eighty years ago we are proposing the following.

- 1. Bunting, union flags and coloured balloons will be put up to decorate the club house.
- 2. War time music and hits of the time will be playing.
- 3. Can those attending please bring along food to share which will be part of an open buffet evoking the street parties taking place.
- 4. Please feel free to dress in the appropriate fashion of the day including make-up and hair style if you wish to further enter into the spirit of the day.
- 5. We shall also be setting aside a table where members are encouraged to bring along any war memorabilia and artifacts that they may possess and be of interest to other members and be a talking point, for example, I shall be bringing along some ration books, an identity card, clothing ration books and allocated co-operative store family ration card.
- 6. Some familiar signs and notices of the war still very much in evidence at the time will also be on display.

So please make a note in your diaries and come along and join us in this once in a lifetime national event with your club!
